**INVITATION FOR THE SUBMISSION OF COMPARATIVE PROPOSALS FOR THE  
DIGITIZATION OF THE PHYSICAL APPREHENSION OF TRAFFIC VIOLATORS UNDER THE SINGLE  
TICKETING SYSTEM (STS) THROUGH THE ELECTRONIC TRAFFIC APPREHENSION PROGRAM  
(ETAP)**

1. On 9 November 2023, the Provincial Government of Bataan ("PGB"), through the Office of the Bataan Public-Private Partnership and Investment Center ("Bataan PPPIC"), received an unsolicited proposal for a Public-Private Partnership arrangement in establishing the digitization of the physical apprehension of traffic violators under the Single Ticketing System (STS) through the Electronic Traffic Apprehension Program (ETAP). The ETAP involves the installation, operation, and maintenance of a system using handheld devices to enhance the No Contact Apprehension Program (NoCAP). By reducing apprehension time and enabling seamless online validation of driver and vehicle information, ETAP improves traffic flow, strengthens road discipline, and promotes efficient traffic enforcement.
2. The project aims to: (1) provide the province with state-of-the-art road rules enforcement through the use of handheld devices and data management software that will help the province enforce traffic rules on its road network; (2) provide the Province of Bataan with a robust system that has undergone rigorous trials and have been used in other jurisdictions; (3) allow greater transparency to lessen the temptation of corruption by the motorist and/or opportunity of extortion from the apprehending traffic enforcer; (4) be able to seamlessly validate the veracity of driver's license and vehicle registration with LTO; (5) efficiently enforce road rules with less time spent in ticket issuance; (6) improve vehicular traffic flow thus lessen carbon emission from vehicles; and (7) establish confidence and building of public trust.
3. The Public-Private Partnership Pre-Qualification Bids and Awards Committee ("PBAC") now invites local and international companies ("Challengers") to submit comparative proposals under a Comparative Challenge Process.
4. The Comparative Challenge Process will be conducted pursuant to and in accordance with the rules and procedures applicable for unsolicited proposals set out in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11966, otherwise known as the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) Code of the Philippines ("PPP Code IRR").
5. Interested challengers may obtain further information from the address below during office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
6. A complete set of Tender Documents may be obtained by interested proponents starting on **15 January 2025** from the address below and upon

payment of the non-refundable participation fee in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 50,000.00) by cash or check.

8. The comparative challenge period will run for ninety (90) calendar days from the issuance of the Tender Documents. Challengers must submit their Qualification Documents, Technical Proposals, and Financial Proposals as one proposal package not later than **7 May 2025, 12:00 PM** at Bataan Public-Private Partnership and Investment Center, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, The Bunker, Capitol Compound, Balanga City. All proposals must be accompanied by a proposal security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in the Tender Documents. Late submissions shall not be accepted.

9. Proposals will be immediately opened in the presence of the challengers' representatives who choose to attend after the above deadline and at the address below.

10. The PPP-PBAC reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, declare a failure of the comparative challenge, modify the Comparative Challenge Process documents or any aspect thereof anytime, and/or not award the project for any reason whatsoever and without need of any explanation.
